

**Girl Scout Camping  
List of Safety Do's & Don'ts**

**Do** wear socks & shoes at all times except when inside tents/cabins/rooms and in the shower or pool.

**Don't** walk around camp in open-toed shoes. If caught you will have to sit down and wait while members of your Troop fetch the proper shoe wear. FYI - this means ADULTS, too!

**Do** tell an adult where you are going and always take a buddy.

**Don't** refuse your buddy when they ask you to go to the bathroom. Your turn may be next.

**Do** pay attention and ask questions when you don't understand the instructions.

**Don't** make fun of others when they ask questions. Be considerate of each person's learning speed.

**Do** walk around fire areas, not through them.

**Don't** step over or on top of logs. Walk around them.

**Do** avoid being taken to the emergency room by walking instead of running.

**Don't** run anywhere unless instructed to do so by an adult. Walk at a moderate pace.

**Do** be considerate of others by being quiet after "Lights Out". {10:00 pm}

**Don't** upset someone by telling scary stories or making scary sounds. Ask everyone's permission in the group before telling something even remotely scary. What is scary to one person, may be funny to another. Be caring and observant of another person's feelings.

**Do** leave an area cleaner than you found it, even if it means cleaning up someone else's mess.

**Don't** scatter your belongings around. Keep them together neatly.

**Do** shine flashlights towards the ground. It will help you to walk without injury. Flashlight beams in the sky only help bugs & birds.

**Don't** shine flashlight beams into people's faces. It is unpleasant when it shines in the face.

**Do** your part to make this trip a very fun and pleasant experience by being a caring, considerate, thoughtful, cooperative and careful camper. Stopping activities to treat emergencies for preventable accidents is very unpleasant. Please think and evaluate your words and actions.
