

PAW Service Unit Campout Camp Champions Packing List

Each Troop may bring snacks and drinks. These items must be stored in the assigned building. You will have access to them all weekend. Please write your troops number on them, as some coolers look alike!

Each Troop must bring a first aide kit. There will be First Aide Kit check when you get to camp. Have it ready to be checked!

Troops should bring some activities in case you finish an activity early or need something extra to do.

Girls and Adults - Items to bring to the campout:

- ❖ Pillow
- ❖ Sleeping bag/bed roll (Adults may want to bring a air mattress)
- ❖ Pajamas
- ❖ Towel / washrag for bathroom use
- ❖ Bathroom items
- ❖ Hair doo-dads
- ❖ Clothes for the weather - rain, cold, and warm
 - Shorts, jeans
 - Short sleeve shirts - NO sleeveless shirts, tank tops or camisoles. This includes Adults. *Remember: White shirts attract bugs - particularly ticks and gnats!*
 - Raincoat or rain poncho
 - Jacket
- ❖ Shoe wear
 - Closed shoes for walking around camp. If rain is forecasted, bring two pairs of shoes.
 - Don't be caught walking around in sandals or flip-flops! There will be a shoe check.
 - Bring shoes that you don't mind getting dirty or muddy.
 - *Shower shoes or flip-flops may be worn in the shower only!*
- ❖ Swimsuit - Acceptable: tankinis or one-piece suits. *No bikinis!*
- ❖ Swimsuit cover-up or old t-shirt
- ❖ Towel for swimming
- ❖ Water bottle
- ❖ Medications in a marked bottle with instructions and given to your Troop's Medicine Woman.
- ❖ Insect repellent
- ❖ Sunscreen
- ❖ Chair or sit-upon (Adults may want to bring a chair, some areas do not have a place to sit)
- ❖ Flashlight & replacement batteries
- ❖ Hat or visor
- ❖ Bandanas
- ❖ Sunglasses
- ❖ Book or something to do during downtime
